- When preparing your manuscript please follow the journal's Guide for Authors closely, which you can find on the online submission site (<http://ees.elsevier.com/vibspec>) - **please do not overlook the maximum length allowed for your paper (see above)**
- In your cover letter, please mention that your manuscript is intended for the **ICAVS6** or **2DCOS6** special issue
